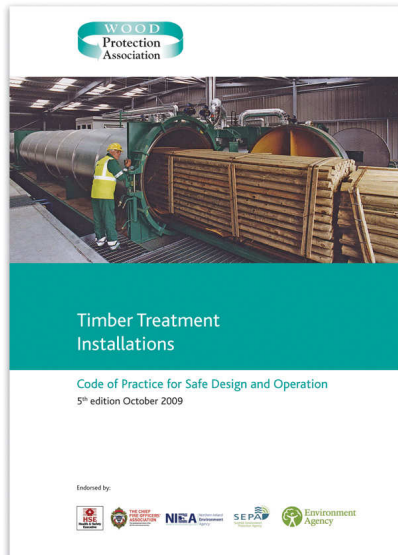

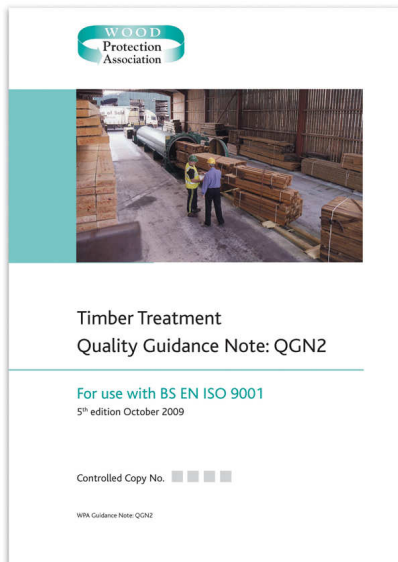


### Timber Treatment Installations Code of Practice for Safe Design and Operation 5<sup>th</sup> edition October 2009

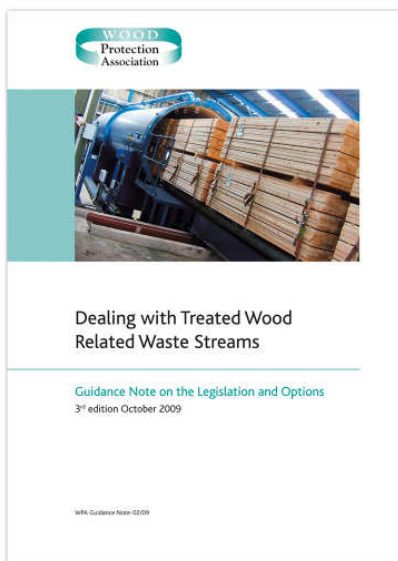
### Timber Treatment Quality Guidance Note: QGN2 5<sup>th</sup> edition October 2009

QGN2 can be used as a stand-alone guide to quality best practice or as a key part of a quality accredited management system. In such management systems QGN2 is listed as a "controlled document", numbered and listed on a register maintained by the WPA. It is an essential part of the Sector Scheme 4 verification audits carried out by UKAS Certification bodies.
